## General Information

The competitions are organized based on the International Competition Rules (ICR) as published on the FIS Homepage. All competitors participating in FIS events must carry accident insurance in sufficient amounts to cover accident, transport and rescue costs including race risks, as well as an appropriate third party liability insurance. The National Associations are responsible for adequate insurance coverage of all their competitors sent and inscribed by them. The NSA or their competitors must be able to show proof of the respective insurance coverage at any time on request of FIS representatives or the OC (ICR 212.4)

## Economical obligations & Reimbursement

### Payment of I-COCJ-W Expenses:

- While we are proud to host the ICOC and FC events, there are some budgetary constraints.  
The time schedule for the ICOC does not require early arrivals or late departures, through a Saturday 14:30 competition start, and a competition end on Sunday 10:30. In other words, the LOC can only fund a maximum of two nights for competing teams.

- Expenses will be paid through bank transfers.
- Prize money is paid at the race office after victory ceremony.
